

**RENOLIT GEOFOL**  
**25-YEAR LIMITED RESIDENTIAL WARRANTY (USA)**

**1. DEFINITIONS**

For purposes of this Limited Warranty (“Warranty”), the term “Product” refers solely to RENOLIT GEOFOL decorative exterior foil applied to approved PVC or aluminum decking profiles in residential applications within the United States.

**2. WARRANTY COVERAGE**

Subject to the terms, conditions, exclusions, and limitations set forth herein, RENOLIT warrants to the acquirer of the Product (“Purchaser”) that, for the Warranty Period defined below, the Product will not:

- (a) Exhibit abnormal color change in excess of two (2) Delta E (CIE) units within the same profile; or
- (b) Exhibit cracking affecting at least ninety-five percent (95%) of the visible foil surface area.

**3. WARRANTY PERIOD & PRORATED SCHEDULE**

This Warranty remains in effect for twenty-five (25) years from the date of Product purchase (“Warranty Period”). Coverage is prorated as follows:

#### **4. EXCLUSIVE REMEDY**

Purchaser's sole and exclusive remedy, and RENOLIT's entire liability under this Warranty, shall be limited strictly to the prorated replacement of foil material or refund of the prorated material value, at RENOLIT's sole discretion. This Warranty does not cover labor, removal, disposal, reinstallation, access costs, inspection fees, or any professional services of any kind.

#### **5. EXCLUSIONS**

This Warranty does not apply, and RENOLIT shall have no liability whatsoever, for any failure, defect, or damage resulting from or arising out of:

- (a) Improper installation, storage, transport, handling, ventilation, gapping, fastening, or failure to follow RENOLIT's written instructions;
- (b) Exposure to chemicals, including but not limited to solvents, acids, alkaline substances, oils, sunscreens, insect repellents, fertilizers, de-icing salts, or pool chemicals;
- (c) Exposure to any heat source exceeding 140°F (60°C), including grills, fire pits, heat guns, non-natural reflections onto the material (e.g. from low-E windows);
- (d) Pressure washing exceeding 1,200 psi, abrasive cleaning tools, metal-edged shovels, scraping, gouging, or impact damage;
- (e) Biological or environmental contamination such as mold, mildew, pollen, dirt, dust, animal excrements (including insects) or grime not removed within seven (7) days;
- (f) Structural movement, substrate failure, warping, twisting, collapse, deflection, settlement, or improper support spacing;
- (g) Weather events including storms, hail, hurricanes, tornadoes, floods, earthquakes, wildfires, or any Act of God;
- (h) Normal weathering, gloss reduction, or color variation within two (2) Delta E units within the first five (5) years, or fifteen (15) Delta E units within another twenty (20) years after the first five (5) years;
- (i) Batch-to-batch color variance or shade differences;
- (j) Use in commercial, industrial, rental, multifamily, or non-residential applications.

#### **6. DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES**

EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED HEREIN, RENOLIT MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, ALL OF WHICH ARE HEREBY DISCLAIMED TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

## **7. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY**

IN NO EVENT SHALL RENOLIT BE LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, SPECIAL, EXEMPLARY, INDIRECT, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO LOSS OF USE, LOSS OF PROFITS, PROPERTY DAMAGE, PERSONAL INJURY, OR LABOR COSTS. RENOLIT'S MAXIMUM LIABILITY IS STRICTLY LIMITED TO THE PRORATED MATERIAL VALUE AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 3.

## **8. CLAIM PROCEDURE**

If a defect exists within the warranty period, RENOLIT must be notified by its direct contractual partner within 30 days after discovery of the defect. The notification must be sent to:

The notification must be in written form and contain the following information: date of discovery of the defect, type of defect, batch number (FOID), delivery date and invoice date.

If RENOLIT is informed later than 30 days after the discovery of the defect, this Warranty shall be void.

## **9. NON-TRANSFERABILITY**

This Warranty applies only to the original residential owner of the property on which the Product is installed and is not transferable to subsequent owners or occupants.

This Warranty gives you specific legal rights. You may also have other rights which vary from state to state.
